

Self Guided Flood Tours

Eastern Loop

From Devils Lake travel east on ND Hwy 2 seven miles to the Minnie H Rest Area. Turn south on the Woods-Rutten gravel road to ND Hwy 20. Follow ND Hwy 20 back to Devils Lake. (approx. 40 miles)

1. Haybail Bay (pasture prior to 1997)
2. Wood-Rutten Road Raise & Bridge
3. ND Hwy 20 Bridge Raise
4. ND Hwy 20/57 Road Raise
5. City Dike

Western Loop

From Devils Lake travel south on ND Hwy 20/57 for one mile and turn west at Lakewood Recreation Area onto Ramsey County Road #1. Return to ND Hwy 20/57 traveling south to Fort Totten. Continue through Ft. Totten to US Hwy 281. Take US Hwy 281 north to Minnewaukan. From Minnewaukan travel north on US Hwy 281 making a right-hand turn onto ND Hwy 19. Travel east to Devils Lake. (approx. 60 miles)

4. ND Hwy 20/57 Road Raise
5. Devils Lake City Dike
6. Eagle Bend Estates - Relocated Homes
Ramsey County #1 - Dead Ends into the Lake
7. ND Hwy 57 Road Raise and Bridge
8. Scenic Overlook at Casino
9. ND Hwy 281 acting as Dike for City of Minnewaukan
10. Six Mile Bay Bridge and road Raise
11. State Outlet
